

Hall of Fame Submissions - Now Being Accepted

Applications for admission into the newly created Halls of Fame are being accepted for the Canadian Bloodhound Club beginning now. All applications received for approval before July 15th 2010 will be awarded at the Canadian Bloodhound Nationals to be held in August 2010. Thereafter, applications received **no later than six (6) weeks before that year's National Specialty** will be awarded at **THAT** year's Nationals. Criteria for acceptance to the Halls of Fame are posted on the website, and listed on the (next) page of this edition of Bloodhounds North. Applications should be submitted with supporting documentation for each of the Halls. For the Performance Hall of Fame, this will consist of copies of title certificates issued by the CBC or CKC. For Brood Bitch and Stud Dog Halls, documentation of titles earned by progeny must be submitted. Show Dog Hall of fame applications must be accompanied by copies of appropriate show catalogs OR JUDGING SCHEDULE, showing the bloodhound entry for the event to validate dogs defeated points. Group placements records can be obtained from the CKC website (RESULTS - SHOWS AND TRIALS), DOGS IN CANADA - (SHOW DOG EDITION) OR BEST DOG IN CANADA WEBSITE

A **onetime** exception to these submission rules will be accepted between now and July 15th 2010, to allow for acceptance of worthy dogs from the Club's past to be admitted into the Halls that they qualify for. Applications must be submitted with as much documentation as possible, but such documentation may consist of written statements of dates and shows, or titles earned whenever possible. Undocumented applications will be subject to review and approval by a committee established for that purpose, consisting of members from the Executive, the Hall of Fame Secretary, and representatives of all the major kennels showing in Canada and with members in the CBC. Decisions of this committee will be final.

We hope to induct many of the distinguished hounds we all know next year at the inception of the Halls- so please plan to join us for the event at the Nationals in Long Sault next summer!



CANADIAN BLOODHOUND CLUB HALL OF FAME APPLICATION FORM

Applicants are responsible for all documentation. Applicants must be a member of the CBC or, in the case of a posthumous application, have been a member of the CBC at some time during the period of qualification. **All titles, points and awards must be accumulated from Canadian Kennel Club sanctioned events and/or Canadian Bloodhound Club sanctioned trailing events.** Applicants should submit application form plus all documentation to the Hall of Fame Coordinator. Upon approval of the application by the coordinator, rosettes and Hall of Fame certificates will be awarded at each year's National Specialty. All applications must be submitted for approval **no later than 6 (six) weeks** before the National Specialty in order for presentation to take place during that year's National Specialty. **Inductions into the HOF are at the discretion of the HOF Committee and all decisions are final.**

BREEDER HALL OF FAME

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Thirty Five Points

In order to qualify for Breeder Hall of Fame Award dogs with the inductee listed as the breeder on the CKC Registration Certificate must have accumulated a total of thirty-five (35) points. Points must come from at least three (3) different dogs. One (1) point for each title recognized by the CBC or the CKC* PLUS one (1) point (limit of 5) for a BIS or HIT

***Does not include CGN Award**

When a **BREEDER** has met all of the above requirements, the Breeder shall submit a completed **Hall of Fame Application**. Upon verification, a certificate(s) will be awarded as indicated on your application.

All Titles must be Canadian Kennel Club and or Canadian Bloodhound Club generated.



DAM HALL OF FAME

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Fifteen Points

In order to qualify for the Dam Hall of Fame Award, fifteen (15) points must be accumulated. Points must come from at least three (3) different get. One (1) point for each title recognized by the CBC or the CKC* PLUS one (1) point (limit of 5) for a BIS or HIT

***Does not include CGN Award**

When a **DAM** has met all of the above requirements, the owner shall submit a completed **Hall of Fame Application**. Upon verification, a certificate(s) will be awarded as indicated on your application.

All Titles must be Canadian Kennel Club and or Canadian Bloodhound Club generated.



SIRE HALL OF FAME

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Twenty Five Points

In order to qualify for Sire Hall of Fame Award twenty five (25) points must be accumulated. Points must come from at least three (3) different get. One (1) point for each title recognized by the CBC or the CKC* PLUS one (1) point (limit of 5) for a BIS or HIT.

***Does not include CGN Award**

When a **SIRE** has met all of the above requirements, the owner shall submit a completed **Hall of Fame Application**. Upon verification, a certificate(s) will be awarded as indicated on your application.

All Titles must be Canadian Kennel Club and or Canadian Bloodhound Club generated.



SHOW DOG HALL OF FAME

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

One Hundred & Fifty Points

In order to qualify for the Show Dog Hall of Fame a dog must accumulate a total number of one hundred and fifty (150) points with at least a minimum of fifty (50*) points coming from the breed level (bloodhounds defeated - *1 point for each bloodhound defeated).

CKC:

All breed Best in Show	10 points
National Specialty BISS	10 points
Hound Specialty BOB	5 points
All Breed Group 1	4 points
All Breed Group 2	3 points
All Breed Group 3	2 points
All Breed Group 4	1 point

****For any given show an individual may choose points from only one of the following; BIS, BISS, Group or Breed points.**

When a Bloodhound has met **ALL** of the above requirements, the owner shall submit a completed **Hall of Fame Application**. Upon verification a certificate(s) will be awarded as indicated on you application.

All wins must be Canadian Kennel Club wins.



PERFORMANCE DOG HALL OF FAME

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

In order to qualify for the Performance Dog Hall of Fame, a dog must accumulate a total number of four (4) CKC or CBC* recognized titles, one of which must be a MT or TD. Documentation proving the titles must be submitted with application.

***Does not include CGN Award**

When a **DOG** has met all of the above requirements, the **OWNER** shall submit a completed **Hall of Fame Application**. Upon verification, a certificate(s) will be awarded as indicated on your application.

All Titles must be Canadian Kennel Club and or Canadian Bloodhound Club generated.
